

Poll Worker Sign Up

Join the Town of Pulaski Election Team!

Help make a difference in our community by serving as a poll worker for the Town of Pulaski.

Various shifts are available:

Full Day: 6:30 AM to close

Half Day (Morning): 6:30 AM to 2:00 PM

Half Day (Afternoon): 1:45 PM to close

Can I be excused from my regular job to be a poll worker?

Wisconsin law requires every employer to grant an unpaid leave of absence to each employee who is appointed to serve as an election official, if the employee who serves as an election official provides their employer with at least seven days' notice. The leave is for the entire 24-hour period of each election day in which the employee serves in their official capacity as an election official. Upon request of any employer municipal clerks must verify appointments.

Individual sign-up requests are sent approximately six weeks before each election. You must be prepared to serve in any position as needed. The Clerk will create the initial schedule; however, on Election Day, the Chief Inspectors may reassign you to a different area based on staffing needs.

Election training is provided in-person, or online for those unable to attend in person, prior to each election.
