Large Equipment Fund: Discussed adding funds to Large Equipment Fund. Motion to add \$15,000 to fund by Bomkamp/second by Bahr. Motion carried.

Patrolman's Report: Snowplowing with Billy on 5 occasions. Mixed salt/chips. Repaired hydraulic line on truck. Equipment maintenance. Obtained CDL license.

Driveway application: Ben Aid will mark the driveway and will be reviewed at February meeting.

Building Inspector: Mike Reuter retired December 31, 2025. Wardell to confirm who the inspector is that is nearest to the township to provide to WI Municipal Building Inspection Agency.

Seasonal Weight Limits: Motion for Meadow Brook Rd and Prairie Rd to be posted for 10-Ton Seasonal Weight Limit, following the dates of set forth by Iowa County by Bahr/second by Bomkamp. Motion Carried.

Republic Service Contract: Credit has been given for fees on the 2-6yd Cardboard dumpsters – should have been billed \$150/month, not \$300. Cardboard can be co-mingled with other recyclables in the large container. Recyclables cannot be disposed of in plastic bags and must be loose due to damage that can be done to equipment. Motion to have contract amended to omit cardboard dumpsters by Bomkamp/second by Bahr. Motion Carried.

Internet Banking Account and Debit Card. Motion for Michek to have account information updated and he will be the keeper of the account by Bomkamp/second by Bahr. Motion carried.

Agricultural Road Improvement Program (ARIP) Grant Opportunity information was reviewed and will be revisited in the future.
