

April 16, 2026 Regular Monthly Meeting of the Town of Pulaski board was called to order by Chairman Dan Imhoff at 7:03pm at the Town Hall at 1727 Clyde St., Avoca, WI.

Approval of March Meeting Minutes: Motion by Bahr/second by Bomkamp. Motion carried

Driveway Applications:

Josh and Jessie Kahl- Fairview Road- Josh was looking to demolish old building and put up new building. To be 1500ft long and will need a pull-off (needs a pull-off over 1000ft). Needs to be 8 ft wide by 15ft. Also needs a turnaround within 75' of house. Existing driveway there, just needs to be brought to current ordinance. Visual inspection will have to be done to ensure this criteria is met. Will be set up as a meeting for Monday April 20, 2026 at 7pm at the residence @1881 Fairview Road Avoca.

Kevin Nankey: Revisiting because it is a shared driveway and will also need a turnaround between the two sets of buildings. Dan will check to see if a permit is needed from Scott Godfrey. Motion for Dan to talk to Godfrey to check to see if permit is needed and to require one if one is.

Public Comment: Jamey Wardell: wondering what the issue was on the erosion runoff complaint and who submitted the complaint

Zorba: wondering about road update.

Road Patrolman's Report: Dan informed that water was coming into the shop where the shop meets the meeting room, as he saw water where water ran across the floor. Will need to be investigated. Tractor's front tires need to be rotated.

Road Inspection Report: Fairview Project will cost \$108k and we will get half of that back, but we will have to cover it until we get it back. Board does not want to carry a loan into next year from work done this year. To get the project done there will be an extra meeting so bid request can go in the paper ASAP and accept the bids in the

regular May meeting. Extra meeting will be held at 6:30pm April 20th, 2026. None of the other projects are as urgent as the Fairview project and that will determine how much other work we can do, therefore it must be figured out first. Determined the only other issue that is urgent is the road bank on Fairview Road near 1796 residence and ditches on Sand Hill Rd and any other non-money-spending projects. Motion by Bomkamp/second by Bahr. Motion carried.

Accepting April 10 meeting minutes and coming back to all other projects when Fairview LRIP Project figured out. Motion by Bahr/second by Bomkamp. Motion carried.

Gravel Bids: Will be sidelined until Fairview Road Project is figured out and will accept at May meeting.

Erosion Complaint: Complaint about erosion runoff on Sugar Loaf Rd from Wardell property. There was a building permit drawn and it would fall under building inspector's authority and he should be made aware.

Pavement Damage on Prairie Road: Was inspected and determined there was no damage.

Road Spreadsheet Update: WHISLR can do this for us by sections of each road and will keep accurate records of road work.

Road Demonstration from localpavement.com: They will come out and fill potholes for free (up to 750ft) for a demonstration. Motion by Bomkamp/second by Bahr. Motion carried.

MUTCD Road Sign Compliance: Must be in compliance with road signs or township could be liable for traffic accidents unless we go around and assess all the road signs and keep a plan on how to update/replace them. The Stop signs and Stop Ahead signs would be first priority. Dan Anderson will make a spreadsheet of all the signs, with a location, and a condition rating. Motion by Bomkamp/second by Bahr. Motion carried.

Culvert Records: Dirk did this but decided it needed to be done again by Dan to update what Dirk did. Spreadsheet with location and condition. No action taken until we find Dirk's notes, ask Shelia if she has this.

Equipment Maintenance Log: Dan to look in filing cabinet to find old logs, and update them.

Transportation Aid Resolution: Approval to sign the transportation aid. Motion by Bomkamp/second by Bahr. Motion carried

Mowing Bids: Schramm Lawncare \$45/mowing. Green Grass Lawncare \$40/mowing for bi-weekly and will contact if it needs to be more. Jerome Schauff \$50/mowing. Accept Schramm Lawncare Motion by Bahr/second by Bomkamp. Motion carried.

Unauthorized Dumping: Dan Imhoff informed Jason that items being dumped such as large plastic bins, furniture, etc. cannot be dumped and need to wait for spring cleanup. Metal can only be dumped if Jason is here and takes it right away. There is also still dumping along the roads even though the gate is open at all times.

Decided to make another sign that this sort of dumping needs to stop as people likely do not realize its prohibited and saying "Town of Pulaski Residents Only". Also a "you are on camera" sign. Decided to post on Facebook page too and website. Ones that were caught on camera will just get a letter informing them these items can only come during spring cleanup and send their picture with the letter. Motion by Bahr/seconded by Bomkamp.

Zoning Request: Dan Prohaska is requesting a zoning change and have sections 022-0785, 022-0782.03, and 022-0786.01 to all be rezoned B2 to build another cabin. However, this is considered a residence and would not have enough acreage (11) to do this under the current regulations because there are already 2 other residences on this property. The sections are small and could be grandfathered in, it was recommended to Dan Prohaska to speak with Scott Godfrey if it is a possibility.

Review of Road Patrolman Contract and Wage: Raise Dan's salary to \$28/hr starting April 1 (for any hours he turns in from this date forward. Motion by Bahr/seconded by Bomkamp. Motion carried.

Chairman Report: If complaints are made, names to not need to be mentioned but everyone on the board must be included in conversations.

Clerk Report: Election: 91 voters out of 205 eligible.
Training: Form CT April 24 \$20 +training time online.
Spring clerk workshop- April 29 Cross Plains \$50 + training time/mileage
Clerk College- Year long Course \$599+ training time/milage
Spring cleanup is May 2, 2026 9am-1pm
Patrolman drug testing done- passed

All of the trainings were already approved and need no action at this time.
